SECTION 6.

There is hereby levied for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 the following taxes of each one hundred dollars (\$ 100.00) assessed valuation of taxable property as listed as of January 1, 2022 for the purpose of raising revenue from the current year property tax as set forth in the foregoing estimate of revenue in order to finance the foregoing appropriations.

SECTION 7.

There is hereby charged for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 the following water and sewer rates for the purpose of raising revenue from the current year utility customers as set forth in the foregoing estimates of revenue in order to finance the foregoing appropriations.

IN TOWN \$9.26/1,000 gallons \$13.13/1,000 gallons

OUT OF TOWN \$18.53/1,000 gallons \$26.26/1,000 gallons

SECTION 8.

The Budget Officer is hereby authorized, except as may be prohibited by law, to transfer appropriations under the following conditions:

- He may transfer amounts between objects of expenditures within a department.
- b. He may transfer amounts between departments of the same fund.
- c. He may make interfund loans.
- d. All non-interdepartmental transfers and loans shall be reported to the governing board at its next regular meeting and shall be entered into the minutes.

SECTION 9.

Copies of the Budget Ordinance shall be furnished to the Finance Officer of Troutman, North Carolina, to be kept on file for his direction in the collection of revenue and expenditures of amounts appropriated.
