<u>National Night Out > >> </u>



Trails & Treats >>>

Dress in Halloween costumes and come trick-or-treat with local businesses and organizations on the Richardson Greenway right through the middle of town on Halloween (10/31) from 4pm-6pm. Historically, this event has been held on our wooded paved trail within our park, but due to concerns surrounding COVID-19, we have moved to the Richardson Greenway-which is longer-so we can disperse vendors further and the line can continue to move without clustering. The line will start at the Downtown Depot end of the Greenway (137 S. Main St.), traveling northbound towards Troutman Town Hall- allowing for only one way foot traffic. A pedestrian walking lane will be created on Eastway Dr. for participants to be able to return back down Eastway Dr., once finished, to get back to their vehicles. All aspects of the event will be supported by staff and volunteers to ensure safety. We ask all participants to consider physical distancing, masks (so many fun costume choices!), gloves, and being respectful of others' space. Vendors will only disperse prepackaged items. - One Stop (Early Voting) ends on Saturday, Oct. 31, 2020 at 3 pm.
- November 3, 2020 General Election Day Voters must vote at their assigned polling place.
- There is NO voting on Monday, November 2, 2020.

Town Meetings—Live Streaming >>>

Town of Troutman began live streaming Town of Troutman Town Council Meetings on April 9. Now other Town Boards and committee meetings are being added to the live streaming.

The public is invited to address the Town Council with comments or concerns. Public comment is limited to three (3) minutes per individual. In person, speakers are required to sign in at the podium and are required to adhere to Town Policy #51 Titled: "Policy Governing Comments from the Public at Town Meetings".

However, please note that this regular meeting is being conducted under an adopted March 30, 2020 State of Emergency Ordinance resulting from the issued NC Governor's Executive Order 121 and revised Executive Order 151 dated July 16, 2020. Therefore, at this time "in-person" attendance will be allowed but limited due to social distancing restrictions. Public comments can be received by mail, email or live stream chat of no more than 350 words up to 5:00 pm the day of the meeting. Contact our office for details 704-528-7600.
